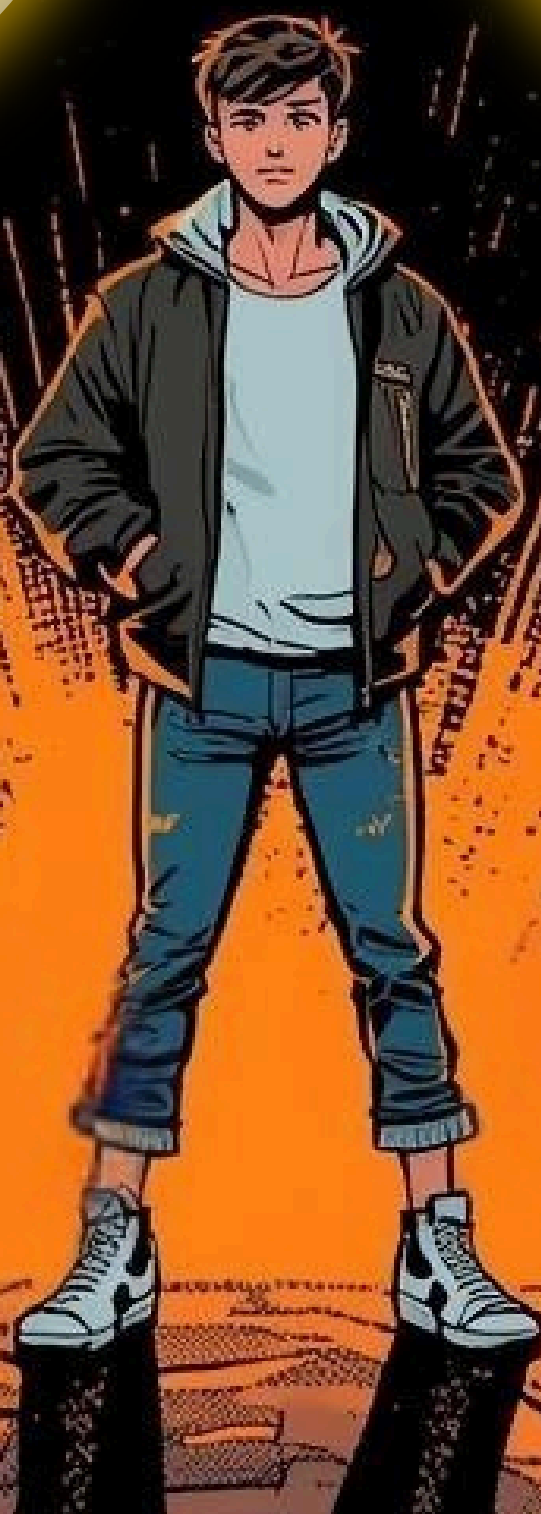

Money mindset

Mind your habits

But very few people see money as a **tool** to generate more money e.g. make it work for them.

A **money-mindset** on the other hand, sees opportunities, "where is the money-tool best used". Might it be saving, investing in learning a skill or buying another tool to earn more money.

Think like an entrepreneur

Don't trade time for money

School teaches you to trade time for money, but this way, you'll hit your earning potential very fast.

Because you have limited time in a day, and you'll eventually get punished for getting better and faster.

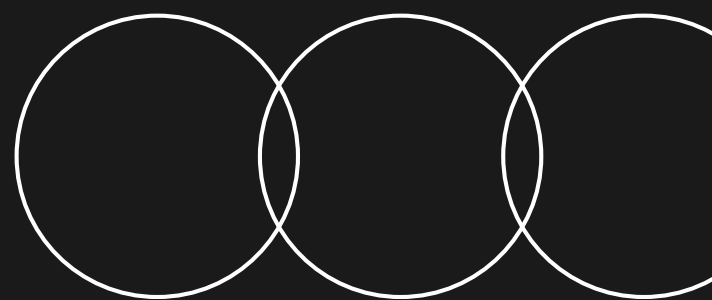
An entrepreneur doesn't trade time for money, they trade money for a product or a service - and **they** put the pricetag on it.

Let's say you clean cars - instead of charging by the hour, you charge per car. This way, as you get faster, you still earn the same (you don't get punished for getting better).

Also, this gives you the option to invest in better tools, better cleaners, some marketing - you invest in **your** business.
